# Trainer

- ▶ Adult responsible for the horse at the show
- ▶ If minor exhibitor has no other trainer, parent/guardian is considered trainer

# Coach

- ▶ Adult who receives payment for teaching a rider
- ▶ SafeSport training is required

# USEF Non-Member Show Pass

- ▶ Valid for Training Level and up
- ▶ Only valid for one show per competition year
- ▶ Only valid for Riders and Owners, not Trainers or Coaches
- ▶ Show Pass riders compete in Open class, not Adult Amateur
- ▶ Must be purchased directly from USEF within 14 days of show

# Membership Exceptions

## Introductory Classes

- ▶ Exempt from all USEF, USDF, and ADA membership, horse registration, and Show Pass fees
- ▶ Drug/admin fee required
- ▶ Eligible for ADA year end awards if member and awards fee paid

## Opportunity Classes


- ▶ Exempt from all USEF, USDF, and ADA membership, horse registration, Show Pass fees, and drug/admin fee
- ▶ Not eligible for year end awards

# Horse/rider awards requirements for ADA

Each fall/winter ADA holds their annual awards banquet to recognize the achievements of our members during the show season. Awards that are presented at the banquet are as follows:

**Level awards** at Training Level, First Level, Second Level and Third Level and above, presented to the top horse and rider combinations, Junior, Adult Amateur and Senior, champion and reserve champion.

**Horse of the year** award, champion and reserve champion.

**Rider of the year** award, champion and reserve champion.

Pas de Deux Award

Quadrille Team Award

## YEAR END AWARD GUIDELINES ADA Level Awards

Training, First, Second, Third/Fourth and FEI Level Awards 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. Awards presented to a horse/rider combination at Training Level, First Level, Second Level, Third/Fourth Level, and FEI Level. The rider must be an ADA member and have paid the ADA Awards Program Fee. The membership and award fees must be received prior to any competition for which scores are recorded. Introductory, Opportunity, Musical, and Prix Caprilli, and Rider Test scores are not included. The winner at each level will be determined by the highest average score. Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will be presented for Open, AA, and Junior riders at each level. Score Requirements for Training Level, First Level, Second Level, and Third / Fourth Level. a. A minimum of six scores at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized shows in Alaska. b. A minimum of three shows and three different judges. c. Two of these six scores must be at the highest test of the level (e.g. Training Level Test 3). d. No more than two of these six scores may be of Test 1. e. The top six scores that meet these requirements are then averaged. A minimum average score of 58% is required to qualify. Score Requirements for FEI Level. a. A minimum of three scores at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized shows in Alaska. b. A minimum of three shows and three different judges. c. The top three scores that meet these requirements are then averaged. d. A minimum average score of 58% is required to qualify. Junior Introductory Level Award 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. Awards presented to Junior horse/rider combinations at Introductory Level. The rider must be an ADA member and have paid the ADA Awards Program Fee. The membership and award fees must be received prior to any competition for which scores are recorded. Opportunity, Musical, and Prix Caprilli, and Rider Test scores are not included. The winners will be determined by the highest average score. Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will be presented. Score Requirements for Introductory Level. a. A minimum of six scores at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized shows in Alaska. b. A minimum of three shows and three different judges. c. Two of these six scores must be at the highest test of the level (Introductory Test C). d. No more than two of these six scores may be of Test A. e. The top six scores that meet these requirements are then averaged. A minimum average score of 58% is required to qualify.

# USDF Year ends Awards

Training, First, Second, Third, and Fourth Levels

From four different USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions

Including two at 60 percent or higher from the highest test of the level

Median score of 60 percent or higher to qualify

Prix St. Georges, Intermediate I, Intermediate II, and Grand Prix

Minimum of four scores:

From four different judges

From four different USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions

Median score of 60 percent or higher to qualify

Eligibility

Horse must have a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) when scores are earned.

Owner must:

Have a USDF Participating Membership (PM) or Business Membership (BM), and be a member in good standing of USDF, when scores are earned.

Verify eligibility with PO.

Verify that an all-breeds declaration has been made by accessing the USDF website.

Rider must have a USDF PM and be a member in good standing of USDF when scores are earned.

If interested in competing for awards in an optional division, it is the owner's responsibility to determine which of the optional divisions will be awarded by their all-breeds PO.

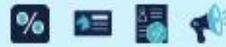

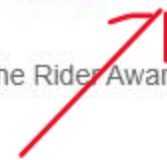

## Eligibility

- Rider must:
  - Have a USDF Participating Membership (PM) or Group Membership (GM) when scores are earned.
  - Be a member in good standing of USDF when scores are earned
- Horse must have a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) at the time scores are earned. Exception: Horses competing only in breed restricted competitions.
- Horse shall be registered with USDF in the name of the owner under which it is exhibited.
- Scores may be earned on one or more horses.

## Recorded Scores & Application

- Rider must submit scores and fee to USDF online using the official [Rider Performance Award Application](#)
- \$25 processing fee for each rider award achieved.

A horse and/or horse/rider combination may appear in the preliminary standings in more than two consecutive levels prior to the standings being finalized. Appearing in the preliminary standings does not guarantee that a horse and/or horse/rider combination will appear in the final year-end award and/or all-breeds standings.

*\*Per USEF DR 119.2, Intermediate I and II are **not** consecutive levels.*
